- 1. Number of Openings: Up to 3 full-time faculty positions (Assistant Professor level and above) for teaching, research, service, and student advising. The expected date of appointment is August 1, 2026.
- **2. Qualifications:** A Ph.D. degree from a domestic or foreign university in a related field such as Electronic Engineering, Electrical Engineering, Communication Engineering, or Telecommunication Engineering. Must be capable of teaching EMI (English as a Medium of Instruction) courses.
- **3. Academic Specialization:** Specialization in related fields such as Communication or Microelectronics, and ability to teach fundamental and laboratory/practicum courses at the undergraduate level.
- **4. Required Application Documents** (Please arrange in order, no binding required):
  - (1) <u>Faculty Application Form</u> (including academic background, work experience, and list of publications) using the National United University's official form.
  - (2) Photocopy of the degree certificate(s) for a Bachelor's degree or higher, OR a <u>commitment letter stating the</u> expected date of Ph.D. completion.

(For foreign degree certificates, proof of verification by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs (MOFA) overseas missions must be attached. Recent graduates must be able to obtain the Ph.D. degree certificate by the end of February 2026.)

- (3) Photocopy of the Ministry of Education (MOE) issued faculty certificate (Assistant Professor or higher). (Not required if not available.)
- (4) Proof of work experience (Please provide proof of employment after obtaining the Ph.D. degree, calculated up to the application deadline.)
- (5) Photocopies of academic transcripts for four years of undergraduate study (including junior college), Master's, and Doctoral degrees.
- (6) 2 to 3 letters of recommendation (Not required for applicants holding an Associate Professor or higher faculty certificate.)
- (7) Ph.D. dissertation abstract information (Please print the result retrieved from the National Digital Library of Theses and Dissertations in Taiwan. Applicants with foreign Ph.D. degrees must provide the dissertation cover, list of oral defense committee members, and abstract) and the first page of academic publications from the last five years.

- (8) Research proposal (Introducing potential future research and estimating required research equipment and funding.)
- (9) Proposed course titles and syllabi for undergraduate and graduate courses (including EMI courses and fundamental courses). Please refer to the department's curriculum for new students and the university's course syllabus format.
- (10) Other documents helpful for the review (Not required if none.)
- (11) Non-R.O.C. applicants must possess basic Chinese speaking ability (Please provide relevant proof.)
- (12) Must complete the "Faculty Application Form" and "Faculty Application Checklist." All electronic documents mentioned above must be emailed to the department contact, Ms. Chen, at <a href="mailto:guanyin@nuu.edu.tw">guanyin@nuu.edu.tw</a> before the application deadline.
- **E-mail Subject:** "Application for Faculty Position in the Department of Electronic Engineering"; The email body must include the applicant's name and contact phone number.

- **5. Review Process:** The first stage is a document review. Qualified applicants will be notified for the second stage, which is an interview.
- **6. Teaching Demonstration Subjects:** Teaching demonstration subjects: Communication Systems Lab, Communication Systems Simulation and Practicum, Electronic Materials, or Modern Physics. Applicants must choose one subject for the demo.
- 7. Interview Schedule and Notes: The department will notify applicants directly regarding the scheduled interview time. Note: Application documents submitted will not be returned. A certain number of reserve candidates may be selected as needed. If the primary candidate declines the offer, the position will be filled sequentially by reserve candidates.
- **8.
