1. Number of Positions:

Up to 6 full-time faculty members at the rank of Assistant Professor or above, responsible for teaching, research, service, and student guidance. Employment is expected to commence on either February 1, 2026, or August 1, 2026, in principle.

2. Eligibility Requirements:

Candidates must hold a doctoral degree in Electronics, Electrical Engineering, Computer Science, or other relevant science and engineering fields from domestic or foreign universities. Applicants must also be capable of offering courses in EMI (Electromagnetic Interference).

3. Areas of Academic Expertise:

Candidates should have expertise in Microelectronics, Communications, Information Technology, or related fields, and be able to teach fundamental undergraduate courses.
